QUICK REFERENCE SHEET

This sheet provides a summary of tournament rules.

It is the responsibility of all teams to know and abide by the complete rules of this event as posted on the Wild Walleye Weekend General Rules Sheet. Failure to comply with any tournament rule may result in disqualification.

- **Tournament Control Contact Numbers: Fred – (231) 645-8366**
- **Fishing Time: 7:00am – 1:00pm each day.**
- **Radio Silence will be in effect. NO COMMUNICATION during tournament hours.**
- **Tournament Limits – DNR Limits – Weigh Your Best 5 – 5 Fish Maximum in cooler for weigh in. Scoring based on aggregate weigh of tournament catch from Saturday & Sunday**
- **All fish DNR size limit**
- **Rules finalized at Captain's meeting**
- **Final payouts posted after Captain's meeting. Payouts will be based on # of entries and will supersede all previous pre-printed material.**
- **9 rods max – 1 bait per rod**
- **No fishing between the end of Day 1 Fishing Period and the start of Day 2 Fishing Period.**
- **Weigh-in begins minimum 2 hours before fishing time ends each day.**
- **Blocked or bagged ice only, no loose ice**
- **Marine Radio Required. Channel will be announced at Captain's Meeting.**
- **Failure to be familiar with all rules may result in DQ, no refunds**
- **Up to \$1000 reward for info that results in DQ for cheating.**
- **Weigh-in at Linwood Beach Marina.**
- **It is your responsibility to verify and sign weigh slip before leaving scales. After weigh slips are signed, you cannot re-weigh.**

**You are responsible for General Rules and Rules pertaining to your event.
Please read them carefully.**

2-Day Tournament

May 14-15, 2010 - Linwood Beach Marina & Campground - Linwood, MI

GENERAL RULES

CAPTAINS MEETING – 7:00pm Friday, May 13th 2010 at Linwood Beach Marina. **One person from each team is required at Captains Meeting.** We would suggest entire team attend. Rules amendments or changes that you will be responsible for knowing may be done at Captains Meeting prior to tournament.

BOAT INSPECTIONS – All registered boats will be subject to inspection prior to each day of tournament fishing. Trailered boats will be inspected as they are launched. Boats docked at Linwood Beach Marina will be inspected prior to departure.

TOURNAMENT TIME – Official fishing period will be from 7:00am – 1:00pm on both days. After launch boats will congregate near to, but a safe distance away from the channel leading into Linwood Beach Marina. A "shot gun start" radio announcement will mark the beginning of the event. After this announcement is made boats may proceed to their desired locations and begin fishing.

TOURNAMENT BOUNDARIES – There are no boundaries for this event, however all boats must leave from and return to Linwood Beach Marina.

FINAL PAYOUTS -Posted at the Captains Meeting for each specific tournament and/or division is based on registration and will supersede **ALL** previously posted possible payouts. Once final payouts are posted there can be no refund of registration fees.

GENERAL RULES - May apply when appropriate to all Tournament Trail and 333 events.

BAD WEATHER - 3 hours of fishing is a completed day. If only 3 hours of a 2-day tournament can be fished it will be considered complete. If we cannot fish the 1st day of a 2-day tournament because of weather, tournament will be canceled for the day. Fishing will be allowed for the rest of the day. After fishing a minimum of 3 hours the 1st day of any 2-day event, no fishing will be allowed for the remainder of that day. Committee is the final authority on weather decisions. If Tournament is called because of bad weather, you will have 1 hour to return to the Harbor. Boats who return more than 1 hour after tournament has been called off will not be allowed to weigh for that day. Monitor channel 9 for safety and emergency information. If tournament is called off before a minimum of 3 hours is fished, the whole day will be canceled. Min 3 hours fishing required to weigh-in. If due to unforeseen circumstances, any event is canceled in its entirety, a refund check for 90% of the registration fee will be mailed within 14 days. 10% of the registration fee will be retained to cover Tournament expenses.

NUMBER OF RODS - Maximum number of lines fishing is 9. Fishing means "in the water." 10 or more lines in the water at any one time disqualifies the team. One bait per rod. No Sliders.

RADIO - Marine radio required. Monitor Channel 9 for communications. Tournament Control will monitor Channel 9 throughout the day in case of an emergency or situation that requires immediate attention. Radio silence will be in effect during this tournament. There is to be no communication between tournament teams using marine radio, cell phone, walkie talkie, or any type of communication device. Any communication to any outside party during tournament hours will result in disqualification.

DNR LAWS – All state DNR fishing laws must be observed. Any DNR written violation on tournament days disqualifies team with no refund regardless of outcome. DNR written violation on tournament day may result in being banned from all future Tournament Trail events.

LIMITS & SCORING – DNR Limits. Weigh your best 5 each day. Maximum of 5 Fish In Cooler for weigh in. Combined aggregate weight for both days will determine final standings.

WEIGH-IN – Linwood Beach Marina. Captain's Meeting will decide final weigh-in procedures for all levels. **TEAMS MAY ONLY BRING 5 FISH TO THE SCALES.** Extra fish or fish under legal DNR Size Limit will result in disqualification of tournament catch for that day. Stretching fish, squashing fish, breaking their neck or any manipulation to increase the length of the fish will disqualify team. Blocked or bagged ice only. No loose cubes or crushed ice, drain water from coolers before weigh-in. **1-LB deduction for loose ice or excess water.** Substances, including ice packed into the fish's mouth or body cavities is cheating and will disqualify the entire team. Weigh slips must be signed before leaving the scales. **CHECK YOUR SLIP BEFORE YOU SIGN. AFTER SIGNATURE RE-WEIGHING IS NOT ALLOWED AND NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE.** Weigh slip will be utilized until after payout of prizes. After that weigh slips will no longer be kept.

CAPTAIN & CREW - A Captain for each team must be designated and identified on registration form. Short-handed crews are allowed, however, sufficient legal fishermen are required to comply with maximum 9 lines. Same fishermen do not have to fish both days. Extra crew will be allowed, however, tournament rod limit must be adhered to.

IDENTIFICATION – Failure to display the identification flag (when provided) at all times during the tournament can result in DQ

DISABLED BOATS - Boats must return under their own power. No boat may come in direct physical contact with another boat for any reason unless authorized by Tournament Control. Physical contact will result in disqualification for both teams. Boats in distress, dangerous or life threatening situations must be dealt with accordingly. Disabled boats that arrive late will not be able to weigh. Once tournament begins you cannot change boats for any reason. Tournament Control will monitor Channel 9.

BOAT SAFETY – **Boat safety remains your responsibility.** Weather conditions vary and the Tournament Rules & Weather Committee will advise when conditions become questionable and may cancel the tournament if deemed necessary. Due to the size variance of boats and varied experience of each captain, the ultimate responsibility for safety belongs to you. If you feel it is becoming unsafe or you are uncomfortable with conditions, your safety and the safety of your crew is **absolutely your responsibility.** If you feel it is not safe for your boat size or experience level proceed to safe harbor immediately.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE - A committee will be selected at each Captains Meeting from tournament participants. This committee will preside over the tournament and handle judgement on weather conditions, disputes, disagreements, or violation of rules. Your participation in this tournament indicates your acceptance of this procedure and your agreement that the decision of the tournament committee will be final. Immediate action for non-compliance of tournament rules will be the jurisdiction of the tournament committee regarding the event in question. **When you elect to fish in any Tournament Trail event you agree by your signature to abide by the policies, rules and decisions set forth by the tournament coordinator and selected tournament committee.**

POLYGRAPH EXAMINATIONS - All participants who weigh fish and are eligible for cash and prizes may be required to submit to a polygraph examination. Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of any and all cash and prizes.

CHEATING - **Cheating will not be tolerated. Anyone caught cheating will be banned for life from all Tournament Trail events and all their names sent to all Great Lakes Tournament Officials. A reward of up to \$1000.00 is offered for information that results in any team being disqualified for obvious cheating.**

PROTESTS - All protests must be submitted within 1 hour after posted tournament fishing time ends each day.
